## Definitions

**Company/Organization** – One or more facilities within New Jersey. Please note that only companies and/or facilities are eligible to receive the Governor's Award and Governor's Continued Excellence Award.

**Facility** – A major component of the overall company structure, comprised of more than one department, housed within a separate physical location where the workers are devoted to serving a particular mission within the overall company mission.

**Department** – One or more groups within a company or facility within New Jersey.

**Governor's Award** – Open to companies or facilities (public or private) within New Jersey. Enrolling in this program will, in a matter of four years without lost time, result in your company or facility being awarded the state's highest safety award. Continued safety excellence will result in your being awarded the Governor's Continued Excellence Award. In order to receive these high-level awards, companies or facilities must have successfully earned the Recognition Award, the Citation of Merit Award, the Division of Public Safety and Occupational Safety and Health Award, and the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development Award.

## Program Requirements

Only injuries and illnesses resulting in a lost-time injury will be counted in determining the performance of a participant. OSHA record-keeping standards will be the basis for reporting.

Entry forms and program information will be mailed to participants before the end of the reporting year, and must be submitted with the registration fee by March 1, 2012, to ensure that awards will be available at the area dinners.

The Awards Committee will supervise all details and shall reserve the right, when a participant becomes eligible for an award, to evaluate the participant's occupational safety and health program and statistics.

**IMPORTANT: A signed OSHA Form 300A and registration must be submitted and paid in full by March 1, 2012, in order to receive your award at an area dinner.**

**Applications postmarked after May 31, 2012, will not be processed.**

## Awards and Eligibility Calendar Year Awards

The following awards are based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31, 2011, and are open to all private and public sector workplaces.

**Departmental Group Award** is awarded to a department within a facility or company for achieving a lost-time incidence rate of 3.0 or less.

**Recognition Award** is awarded to a facility or company for achieving a lost-time incidence rate of 3.0 or less for the calendar year.

**Citation of Merit** is awarded to a company, facility, or department for working throughout the calendar year without lost time from a work-related injury or illness.

## Major Awards

**Division of Public Safety & Occupational Safety & Health Award** is awarded to a company, facility, or department that has participated in the program for two consecutive calendar years without lost time from a work-related injury or illness. The recipients must have previously received the Citation of Merit Award.

**Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development Award** is awarded to a company, facility, or department that has participated in the program for three consecutive calendar years without lost time from a work-related injury or illness. The recipients must have previously received the Division of Public Safety & Occupational Safety & Health Award.

**Commissioner's Continued Excellence Award** is awarded to departments that have participated in the program for four or more consecutive calendar years without lost time from a work-related injury or illness. The recipients must have previously received the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development Award.

**Governor's Award** is awarded to a company or facility that has participated in the program for four consecutive calendar years without lost time from a work-related injury or illness. The recipients must have previously received the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development Award.

**Governor's Continued Excellence Award** is awarded to a company or facility that has participated in the program for five or more consecutive calendar years without lost time from a work-related injury or illness. The recipients must have previously received the Governor's Award.
